Privacy Policy Information

About this doc

This document will describe to you the kind of information that Atmos requires, uses, and how some features of the site are operated.

How emails are handled

Your email is only used for a few functions of the site. With it, you will need to enter it during the sign-up process when making your account. Afterwards, it is only used again when you wish to sign-in. Your email will not be used for any other purpose and will not be shared or revealed to third parties. Your email is used when you request a password reset, when a email verification is required, or when a notice needs to be sent regarding your account. When contacting a staff member, the address you sent the email from will only be seen by the staff and does not have to be the same email as a registered account that you own, but the registered address may be requested in some cases. Your email will never be used for

spam purposes, and it will also not receive emails from users who do not have administrator access. You may also encounter a opportunity to sign in with Google on some pages of the site. The only information recorded by Atmos is the Google account ID, and when required, only public information is accessed.

Cookies

When visiting the site for the first time, you may encounter a message notifying you about cookie usage on your device. This cookie records only minimal information, which is related to login information. If you deny the cookies, you may need to sign in more frequently. Another cookie is also stored, which only records when you acknowledge the cookie consent. Post privacy

Your posts belong to you, and are visible to only those you choose. However, administrators can view certain content when need-be.

Administrators have the ability to view flagged NSFW content, or any other reported content that has been flagged either automatically or by another user of the site. Typically, your average post will not be seen by an administrator, but more extreme content might require processing to determine if flagged content will be removed or left up. More information is available on the Terms of Service document.

Deleting posts

When you delete your post, your post will be invisible to both you and whoever it was shared with. However, administrators will be able to view deleted content when need-be for a maximum of 30 days from the time of deletion. This allows administrators to review deleted content, and to

provide recovery assistance if necessary. Measures will be taken to ensure your deleted content stays secure, and appropriate action will be taken if this function is abused by an administrator.

Security

When using Atmos, your IP address, as well as user agent(s) will be logged. This is so that you can understand who has logged into your account, which can help you decide if you should secure your account. Using an IP address, a state or province can be shown. Only you have access to this information, and measures will be taken to ensure your location and IP data stays secure, and appropriate action will be taken if this function is abused by an administrator.
